

10KNOTS 2008 PINOT NOIR



APPELLATION: Edna Valley, California

WINEMAKING: Fruit from our MacGregor Vineyard, one of the oldest in the Edna Valley, produces the finest Pinot Noir year in and year out. Influenced by the cooling coastal climate, early morning fog and afternoon breezes allow the grapes to reach maturity slowly and evenly. 87 Cases Produced.

TASTING NOTES: At the crossing of a subdued but nuanced Burgundian traditional style and the vibrance of California Central Coast offerings of Pinot Noir, this wine combines the virtues of both. The notes of strawberries and raspberries are pronounced while mushrooms and earth become evident too. The chewy tannins enable a complex structure towards a rustic palate while the juicy acidity and the hint of vanilla from aging in French barrels dovertail for a nice finish.
