Tasting Notes: Arriving at the best possible blend through precise iterations of barrel tasting results in a wine such as the 2010 Sextant Night Watch. Deep Ruby facets gleam from the glass as violets, jasmine, and leather notes appear on the nose. Dark cherries and dried cranberries surge to the front of the palate while notes of red currants and pomegranates dilly-dally at the back. Limber tannins give body and structure to this savory and lively fusion. The rousing finish sings the virtues of this Petite Sirah and Zinfandel duet, a harmonious rhythm of flavor.
