WINEMAKING: Grenache based GSM. 100% Estate fruit. Aged for 23 months in 20% New French Oak. 50% Grenache, 37% Syrah, 13% Mourvedre. 182 cases produced.

TASTING NOTES: A convivial Southern Rhone style blend, the 2010 Sextant 'Portolan' is fragrant with spices and heavenward with flavor. The trio of Grenache, Syrah, and Mourvedre somehow produces both wild and polished notes of strawberries, blackberries, and cassis. Mesquite and kirsch accentuate the mid-palate proving suppleness and density. Fine but sustained tannins hold the profile together giving way to a smooth and flowing texture. Finally, hints of black tea and ganache become evident on the exquisite finish.
