WINEMAKING: Our Estate bottled Cabernet Sauvignon was fermented in stainless tanks and aged in New French Oak (24%) for 22 months.

Tasting Notes: Concentrated and pure, this Sextant Paso Robles Cab begins with a lovely overture of cherries, blackberries, and plums underscored with tar, licorice, and tobacco notes. Whiffs of lavender and sage add to the complexity while a touch green bell peppers and black truffles glide into the profile. The tannins are soft but lively and frame the effusive and seamless structure. Surging with every swirl, the flavors crest then ripple wonderfully on the undulating finish.
