APPELLATION: Paso Robles, California

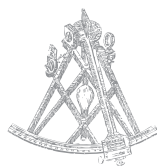
WINEMAKING: Aged 21 months in 20% New French oak barrels.
92 Cases Produced.

TASTING NOTES: Tannat is a grape varietal well-suited to Paso Robles terroir vinified by Sextant Wines in a rustic style reminiscent to that of its origins in Southern France. Multidimensional and full-bodied, there's a backbone of plump blackberries graced with sweet spices. Voluptuous layers of dark plums and boysenberries mingle with spicy notes of sage, thyme, and mint. The soft tannins frame a shapely structure towards a rounded and concentrated finish.
