TASTING NOTES: The first impression of the Sextant 2009 Late Harvest Sauvignon Gris is that it's like liquid Apple Pie a la mode. This wine continues to please the palate with resplendent honey notes, ripe figs, and orange marmalade. Prolonged hang time on the vine has allowed nature to imbue this vintage with exquisite flavors. Coupled with meticulous winemaking, the result is a shiny brass hue, a pleasing aroma, and a buoyant sweetness that livens the occasion. Served slightly chilled, it's cool nectar for dessert all on its own.
