Tasting Notes: The 2011 Sextant Kamal evokes traditional Bordeaux winemaking but with its own Paso Robles character and provenance. Dense flavors of crushed blackberries and lively black currants make an immediate impression on the palate. Tiers of lush cherries and dark plums become evident just when subtle vanilla and tobacco box layers appear at the periphery. Pliable tannins weave the profile into a powerful, but all the while, graceful finish.
