WINEMAKING: Saignée of Grenache fermented and aged 4 months in neutral oak barrels. 226 Cases Produced.

Tasting Notes: The unique growing conditions of a vineyard have a direct effect on the quality of the wine and the characteristics of the Grenache varietal have a direct effect on the contours of a quality rose. The 2012 Sextant Grenache Rose from Paso Robles features crisp notes of strawberries and raspberries with charming accents of ripe cherries. Hints of almonds, chamomile, and licorice slide eventually into the profile as racy acidity delivers a mouthwatering finish. A wine designed to be light and refreshing might as well be bright and revitalizing!
