Sextant 2013 Santa Lucia Highlands Chardonnay





APPELLATION: Santa Lucia Highlands, California

WINEMAKING: Fruit sourced from Sarmento Vineyards in the prestigious Santa Lucia Highlands appellation of Monterrey County. Barrel fermented and aged sur lie for 10 months in 30% new American oak barrels. Lees were stirred weekly for the first two month of aging to create it's creamy texture.

Tasting Notes: Adorned with fragrant floral notes, the 2013 SLH Chardonnay displays white peaches and apricot flavors integrated with chamomile and nutmeg. A nuanced tinge of honeydew melon and lemon peel add complexity. Crisp acidity and exquisite body lead the way to a persistent finish. The hallmarks of this wine are finesse and simple elegance.
