TASTING NOTES: Tannat continues to show promise in developing into one of the region's signature varietals. Quickly becoming a Paso Robles favorite, the essence of this alluring varietal is the intersection between savory and sumptuous. It shows plenty of character up front as wild raspberries mix with layers of kirsch and strawberry jam. Earthy underbrush, tobacco, and espresso appear while pomegranate and cinnamon notes rush the palate. A bit taut at the leading edge, the finish turns smooth and delectable at the trailing edge.
