## Sextant 2014 Marselan Cabernet Sauvignon X Grenache



APPELLATION: Paso Robles, California

WINEMAKING: Sextant is very proud to be the first winery to plant Marselan in the United States. Barrel aged for 18 months in 30% new French oak this variety is a very intriguing hybrid of Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache. Hand crafted and fermented in 1 1/2 ton open top fermenters this wine exudes rustic style.

**TASTING NOTES:** Exuding the Yin and Yang of the two varieties that make up this hybrid our X-Series Marselan is both a brooding bystander and a fleshy interloper. Upon entry the dark, earthy, tannic and mocha character from the Cabernet Sauvignon genes show themselves. The mid-palate explodes with the fresh strawberry-rhubarb and nutmeg originating from its Grenache genes. This rich wine is long in the mouth and finishes with refined tannins lingering long after the last sip.
