WINEMAKING: Hailing from Shell Creek Vineyard originally planted in 1972 and nestled amongst the limestone foothills near Shandon California this Petitie Sirah is aged in 10% new American oak, 10% new French oak, and 10% new Hungarian oak and barrel aged for 22 months.

TASTING NOTES: The 2014 Shell Creek Petite Sirah is an ode to boysenberries. Rich, potent, and concentrated, it's a wine to satisfy a craving for a bold and savory inkling. Blackberries, kirsch, and white pepper add to the boysenberry base. Limber tannins frame a chewy texture with deep color and depth. This wine has a place on the holiday table to pair with turkey and all the fixings in helping to complete the setting for an ode to joy.
