
## Sextant 2015 Petite Sirah Shell Creek

WINEMAKING: Hand picked fruit sourced from the prestigious Shell Creek Vineyard just on the east side of Paso Robles, this 100% Petite Sirah captures the true elegance of this amazing varietal. Aged in 38% new oak, comprised of both French and American to round out this powerful varietal.

**TASTING NOTES:** Named "petite" for its small berries that amount to a flavorful skin-to-pulp ratio, this wine is full-bodied and concentrated and amounts to a favorable fun-to-drink ratio. Hoist a glass to release lavender and white pepper on the nose. Eye the inky violet hue beckoning for further investigation. Swirl a mouthful to enjoy boysenberry, blackberry, and blueberry notes. Sense the smooth acidity woven with supple tannins, then taste the intricate clove and briary accents on the big, savory finish.
