WINEMAKING: A multi-vintage estate blend done in small lot fermentations our Genoa is in a class of its own. A blend crafted from only the best blocks of Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Zinfandel across multiple vintages each blend of our Genoa has a portion of all of the previous vintages as part of its lineage. Our XVII Genoa, like all of our Genoa blends, carries the history of our past and starts a journey into the future.

TASTING NOTES: The Genoa XVII is not so much a "non-vintage" wine; it's rather a multi-vintage gem. It's a delectable consequence of directed tasting sessions of reserved batches. Aroma, flavor, depth, body, are all taken into consideration when constructing, layering, and considering the end result. The profile starts with a potent core of blackberries, blueberries, and boysenberries. Velvety tannins and reserved acidity frame a velvety mouthfeel. Grilled herbs, cracked pepper, and tobacco notes begin to waft when swirled. After a long sip, when the components come together, a remarkable wholeness becomes evident. Elegance and purity from the vineyard come through on the persistent finish, the art and craft of blending having been demonstrated.
